A memorial tree is a creative way to commemorate one of life's milestones, from weddings and anniversaries, to the birth of a child, or a memorial to a loved one or relative who is no longer with us. Memorial trees may also serve to commemorate groups or individuals that have had meaningful impacts on society.

A one-time donation of \$1,500 lets you place the tree of your choice in a village park that is special to you.

With the donation of a tree, you will receive a memorial bronze plaque that will be mounted at the base of the tree. The memorial plaque will have the text submitted by the interested party and approved by the Department of Public Works.
